A letter card of the ship as Troop Transport for the 2nd Convoy of troops to Egypt.


**SS BERRIMA - P & O BRANCH LINE -** Taken over by the government while in Sydney, sent to Cockatoo Island and fitted out in 6 days to carry 1500 officers and men, with a hospital installed on the upper deck.

Departed Sydney,19th August 1914, escorted by **HMAS SYDNEY** as far as Palm Island where other war ships and supply ships arrived before departing for Port Moresby to link up with **KANOWNA** and headed for Rabaul.

HMAS SYDNEY - brand new Light Cruiser (one of two in Australia), supported the attack on Rabaul before going to support New Zealand's attack on Samoa. Dispatched from 1st Convoy to deal with SMS EMDEN, the unidentified ship at Cocos Island resulting in EMDEN's total destruction

## Australian Naval & Military Expeditionary Force

**HMAS SUBMARINE AE1** - the 1st of 2, E Class submarines built for the Royal Australian Navy in 1913, manned by Royal Navy Officers and a mixed crew of both R N and Australian ratings. Accompanied by sistership **AE2** made the longest transit distance ever travelled by a submarine at that time.

The submarines created another record having steamed 1200 miles without an escort, when they arrived off Rabaul from Sydney. Following the surrender of Rabaul, while patrolling the next day, 14th September, 1914, was seen by **HMAS PARRAMATTA** mid afternoon, but, failed to return that evening. She is believed lost.



**HMAS YARRA** - one of 3 destroyers in the Australian Navy sent the next day to search for the vanished **AE1**.

No trace of the submarine was ever found
