

We all have our treasured finds and sometimes these come from the most unexpected places. I, like many members I'm sure, am always on the look out at local markets and Op shops etc. for that elusive postcard find which are becoming more and more scarce.

Still it doesn't stop us looking and occasionally it still pays off.

My find was at the monthly Sunday market in Goolwa which has a varied mix of around 30 stalls.

A very picturesque spot and if the weather is fine, a perfect way to spend an hour or two. Add in a coffee and the local produce and it's hard to beat.

One of the occasional sellers I have seen before had a box of postcards which contained the typical mix of UK and European holiday spots but motivated with the Fleurieu sunshine and caffeine hit, I persevered with working my way through them all.

Three quarters of the way through I found the two cards below and being an avid movie collector was very pleased and added them to a handful of interesting but average cards.

Guys and Dolls was a major production for MGM in 1955. Starring Marlon Brando, Jean Simmons, Frank Sinatra and Vivian Blaine, directed by Joseph L. Mankiewicz and produced by Samuel Goldwyn.

A musical that went on to win Golden Globes for Best Motion Picture - Musical or Comedy and for Jean Simmons as Best Actress in a Motion Picture – Musical or Comedy, as well as many Academy Award nominations.
